LAMDA File Sheet

- We recommend a lever arch file, with dividers between the sections and some things in plastic wallets. Presentation is very important as is ease and speed of access.
- You may choose to keep a notebook in addition but this must be kept in or with the file, updated and cross referenced then made accessible to your Tutor at any time.
- If you have already done an exam you must sort out your file before the start of your next one ie carry forward anything relevant and archive anything merely specific in section 9.
- All tutors will check these files at intervals throughout the term and they will make up a large part of the mark for knowledge in the mock exam.

1) Pieces

Several copies double-spaced, no stage directions from script. Versions marked with: Pauses, stresses, vocal work Moves, blocking, staging Character objectives/actioning the text Intensity of mood

2) Lesson summaries

Plan of the term with a breakdown of all lessons (work and admin) Bullet points of everything covered in lesson – **what** and **why?** Clear and neat list of work to do before next lesson – anything needed to carry forward?
